

ADVISING FOR THE ASSOCIATE DEGREE

A. Student must complete English 102 with a “C” grade or better.

Exemptions

- There are special cases where students qualify for exemption from English 102. Please see page 31 of the UW - Waukesha Catalog.
- CAUTION: Exemption from English 102 at the UW Colleges does not guarantee exemption from English 102 at a Baccalaureate Campus.

B. Math 110 or Math 108 must be completed with a “C” or better

Exemptions

- Completion of Math 124, a 200 level math course of 3 or more credits, or both Math 110 and Math 113 with a grade of “C-“ or better will exempt the math core requirement and can be used as 5 credits in the Math and Natural Science category
- A student is exempted by mathematics placement into a 200 level course
- Completion of Math 108 and Math 110 with a “C” grade or better may use one course for the core requirement and the other as a Math and Natural Science Elective.

C. A student must complete a minimum of 32 credits in Breadth Requirements.

- **Fine Arts and Humanities:** A minimum of nine credits must be earned in this category with at least one course in Humanities and one course in Fine Arts. A third course may be either Humanities or Fine Arts.
- **Mathematics and Natural Sciences:** A minimum of 11 credits must be earned in this category with at least eight credits in **two** Natural Science disciplines. One Lab Science is required.
- **Social Sciences:** A minimum of nine credits in the Social Sciences. One course in at least **two** different disciplines is required.
- **Application and Performance:** A minimum of three credits in Application and Performance is required.
- **Ethnic Studies and Interdisciplinary Studies:** A student must take a 3 credit interdisciplinary studies (IS) and a 3 credit Ethnic Studies (ES) class. These classes may have more than one designation for Specific Requirements and may also count as a Humanities, Fine Arts or Social Science. The credits for these classes, however, can only be counted in one category.

D. The culmination of the Core + Breadth + Additional Breadth + Electives must equal 60 credits or higher for the completion of the Associate of Arts and Science Degree.

E. Students must maintain a grade point average of at least a 2.0 in all of the credits earned at UW – Waukesha and any credits earned at a previously attended institution that are being applied towards the Associate of Arts and Science degree.
