<sup>3</sup> Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher in the equivalent of UWM's COMMUN 101, 103, (UWC's COM 101 and 103) and 105 is required for admission to the major, minor, or concentrated study. COMMUN 105, Business and Professional Communication, is required for entry into the major but is NOT offered by the UW-Colleges.

<sup>4</sup> Recommended electives include: COM 110, COM 160, COM 210, COM 230, COM 266, COM 298, COM 299.

**APPLICATION :** Submit a UW System application form and all appropriate transcripts to the Department of Enrollment Services . If you meet UWM standard admission requirements, you will be admitted directly into the College of Letters and Science. **Application Priority Dates:** Fall - August 1; Spring - December 15

**REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY INTO THE MAJOR:** Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher in the equivalent of UWM's COMMUN 101, 103, and 105 is required for admission to the major, minor, or concentrated study. Earn a 2.0 cumulative GPA on 12 or more attempted credits. You may transfer up to half the credits required for graduation from UWM, but usually not more than 72 credits.
